Biography

Joaquín de la Cuesta is a Spanish conductor (orchestra and choirs) and double bassist, born in Lleida (Spain) and based in Iceland. His work centres on artistic direction, programme thinking, and long-term repertoire development. He trained in symphonic conducting (ABRSM) and holds conservatory-level qualifications in double bass and choral/orchestral conducting in Barcelona.

He combines a solid command of core symphonic repertoire with a distinctive focus on Spanish symphonic music of the nineteenth century and the early decades of the twentieth. This specialism shapes his artistic profile and informs programmes that connect established concert traditions with repertoire discovery—bringing lesser-known Spanish works into a modern orchestral context in a way that remains audience-focused and presentable to international presenters.

Recent conducting engagements include the Filharmonia Zabrzańska (Zabrze, Poland) and Strengsveitin Spiccato (Reykjavík), as well as invitations to conduct the Wiener Postsymphony (Vienna) and the Orquesta Sinfónica Estable de Tucumán (Argentina).

De la Cuesta has worked with orchestral and choral ensembles in several countries and continues to develop projects across symphonic and choral formats. His background as a double bassist includes extensive orchestral experience; he was a member of the Joven Orquesta Nacional de España (JONDE) and has performed in a range of professional settings in Spain and Iceland. In Iceland, he has also been active as an instrumental teacher and ensemble leader, complementing his conducting work with a strong educational profile.

Alongside performance, he pursues musicological and editorial interests centred on Spanish repertoire, reflecting a commitment not only to interpretation but also to the rediscovery and preparation of rarely performed works. This combination of practical musicianship, research-driven programming, and stylistic affinity for Spanish symphonic literature defines his artistic signature: a conductor with a clear identity, capable of delivering mainstream repertoire with reliability—while offering presenters a compelling, distinctive repertoire perspective.

Biografie

Joaquín de la Cuesta ist ein spanischer Dirigent (Orchester und Chor) und Kontrabassist, geboren in Lleida (Spanien) und mit Lebensmittelpunkt in Island. Sein Profil verbindet künstlerische Leitung, Programmgestaltung und langfristige Repertoireentwicklung. Er absolvierte eine Dirigierausbildung an der ABRSM und verfügt über konservatorische Abschlüsse in Kontrabass sowie Chor- und Orchesterdirigieren in Barcelona.

Er verbindet das internationale symphonische Kernrepertoire mit einem ausgeprägten Schwerpunkt auf der spanischen Symphonik des 19. Jahrhunderts und der ersten Jahrzehnte des 20. Jahrhunderts. Diese Spezialisierung prägt sein künstlerisches Profil und fließt in Programme ein, die etablierte Konzerttraditionen mit Repertoire-Entdeckungen verbinden – und weniger bekannte spanische Werke in einen modernen Orchesterkontext stellen, der publikumsnah bleibt und zugleich eine klare programmatische Handschrift trägt.

Zu seinen jüngeren Dirigierengagements zählen die Filharmonia Zabrzeńska (Zabrze, Polen) und Strengsveitin Spiccato (Reykjavík) sowie Einladungen zur Zusammenarbeit mit der Wiener Postsymphony (Wien) und der Orquesta Sinfónica Estable de Tucumán (Argentinien).

De la Cuesta arbeitete mit Orchester- und Chorensembles in verschiedenen Ländern und ist sowohl im symphonischen als auch im chorischen Bereich tätig. Sein Hintergrund als Kontrabassist steht für umfangreiche Orchestererfahrung; er war Mitglied der Joven Orquesta Nacional de España (JONDE) und trat in Spanien und Island in vielfältigen professionellen Kontexten auf. In Island war er zudem in der Musikvermittlung und Ensemblearbeit aktiv und ergänzt seine Dirigiertätigkeit durch ein ausgeprägtes pädagogisches Profil.

Neben seiner Dirigiertätigkeit widmet sich de la Cuesta editorischen Projekten mit Schwerpunkt auf spanischem Repertoire und setzt sich für die Wiederentdeckung selten gespielter Werke ein. Diese Repertoirearbeit fließt unmittelbar in seine Programmgestaltung ein.
